On Griffin Road at Site #8 for the guard rail project, we have three options for you and council to choose from.

Existing Conditions: Two 12.5 feet long straight sections, west side of Griffin Road

Option #1 - Add one 12.5 feet long straight section to the existing section. Cost \$2700

**Option #2** – Remove one 12.5 feet long straight section and place in City storage. Add two 12.5 feet curved sections to the one remaining existing section. <u>Cost \$3033</u>

**Option #3** – Remove one 12.5 feet long straight section and install it on the east side of the Griffin Road. Add two 12.5 feet curved sections to the one remaining existing section. <u>Cost \$3633</u>

Option #1 is the least expensive and would accomplish the goal but it would not look correct. Plus the price is almost the same as Option #2 — Option #1 is not worth considering. The Contractor stated that the prices are roughly the same due to the cost of shipping. Option #2 would look a lot better. Councilman Lee asked if we should place one on the east side of the road. That side isn't as critical, but you would have that extra section that would not be doing any good in storage. I recommend Option #3, but if the budget is a concern, then Option #2.
